- God's plan for love, sex and life (Genesis: 2:24, "This is why a man leaves his father and mother and joins himself to his wife, and they become one body."; Genesis 1:27, "..in the image of God He created them, male and female He created them; Genesis 1:28, "..Be fertile and multiply, fill the earth..")
- The Sacrament of Marriage and the wedding vows: the commitment to love as Christ loves - freely, totally, faithfully and fruitfully. The unitive and procreative meanings of marital union.
